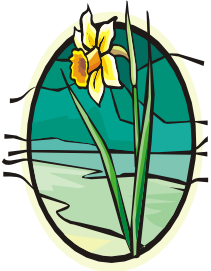

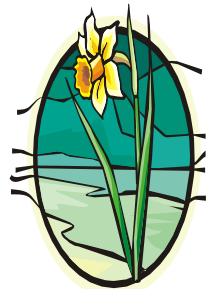
Spring Has Sprung!!!

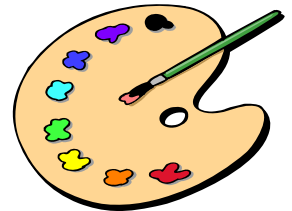
Easter Closing
